<b>Bank Holiday</b> (Emergency Banking Act) March 9-12, 1933	-Bank runs caused 11,000+ banks to fail by 1933; even healthy banks. -The public had lost faith/confidence in banks	1) Closed all banks for 4 days & required a federal audit of each bank's books to verify that they were sound (4 out of 5 were OK) 2) Only good banks were reopened on the 13 <sup>th</sup> 3) \$1 billion was redeposited, confidence restored	-Banks -Consumers
