In a 6-8 paragraph essay, construct a unique claim about the 2016 American Presidential Election that both responds to the article "Hillary Clinton and the Populist Revolt", and can be substantiated by what you have learned about America's

- political culture and ideology (the American Creed, liberal vs conservative, etc)
- media (roles played)
- political party system (Democrats vs Republicans vs 3<sup>rd</sup> parties)
- method of electing a President (primaries, campaigns, debates, Electoral College, etc)

## IN YOUR ESSAY, IT IS IMPORTANT THAT YOU:

- Respond to issues addressed in the *New Yorker* article
- Discuss relevant evidence that substantiates your position: exit polls, electoral map
- Utilize descriptive and appropriate political terms and examples demonstrating knowledge of listed topics
- Include your final evaluation of the "health" of the American body politic and your expectations of a Trump presidency in your conclusion

You can probably write this response off the top of your head—just do so with your notes open, to make sure you are utilizing the relevant political terms and facts you have learned to substantiate your thoughts!

Please double-space, use 12 pt font, and 1" margins.
